

RESOLUTION NO. 414

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CCR_x OF NEW YORK, LLC REGARDING PHARMACY SERVICES FOR THE NURSING HOME

By Social Services Committee and Mr. Scavo:

WHEREAS, The Executive Director of the Department of Residential Health Care Facilities has requested legislative authorization to enter into a two-year agreement with CCR_x of New York, LLC in the amount of \$850,000 for the period beginning January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2011 regarding the provision of comprehensive pharmaceutical services at the Albany County Nursing Home, and

WHEREAS, The Department, through the County Purchasing Agent, issued a request for proposals for cost-effective pharmacy services at the Nursing Home and in July five proposals were received, and

WHEREAS, Nursing Home officials reviewed said proposals and have recommended awarding the contract to CCR_x of New York, LLC as the best value for Albany County to provide drugs, over-the-counter pharmacy supplies, consultation and cost-saving pharmaceutical services for residents of the Nursing Home, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a two year agreement with CCR_x of New York, LLC, 84 Patrick Lane, Poughkeepsie, NY in an amount not to exceed \$850,000 beginning January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2011 regarding the provision of comprehensive pharmaceutical services at the Nursing Home, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
