AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS REGARDING THE GREEN JOBS CORP PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance in the amount of \$300,000 for the period beginning October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010 regarding the Green Jobs Corp Program in Albany County, and

WHEREAS, Green Jobs Corp funding will provide education, training and subsidized employment placements of up to 35 hours a week for green jobs in the fields of weatherization, energy efficiency, environmental conservation, renewable energy and natural resource preservation, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has also requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the Altamont Program, Inc. to provide public assistance recipients employment opportunities in green jobs in the amount of \$300,000 for the period beginning October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 for the period beginning October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010 regarding the Green Jobs Corp Program in Albany County, and, be it further

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Altamont Program, Inc. to provide Albany County public assistance recipients employment opportunities in green jobs in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 for the period beginning October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
