AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH BI, INC. REGARDING GPS ELECTRONIC MONITORING OF SEX OFFENDERS

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 202 for 2005, this Honorable Body requested County officials to strengthen efforts to protect children and others from sexual predators, including the possibility of initiating electronic tracking of designated sex offenders convicted of violent crimes and those deemed to be at a high risk of re-offending, and

WHEREAS, The Probation Department has requested authorization to renew the agreement with BI, Inc. to provide and maintain GPS electronic monitoring services for probation-sentenced sex offenders determined to be at high risk to re-offend for a fee of \$7.00 per probationer per day for a two-year period commencing December 1, 2009 and ending November 30, 2011, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with BI, Inc., 6400 Lookout Road, Boulder, CO 80301 regarding GPS electronic monitoring of sex offenders for a fee not to exceed \$7.00 per probationer per day for the period commencing December 1, 2009 and ending November 30, 2011, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
