

RESOLUTION NO. 427

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY REGARDING A REGIONAL PET AND COMPANION ANIMAL SHELTERING PROGRAM AND AMENDING THE 2009 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has indicated that the NYS Office of Homeland Security has made available \$50,000 to implement a Regional Pet and Companion Animal Sheltering Program, and

WHEREAS, This program would increase capabilities in the region to shelter family animals in the event of a disaster requiring an evacuation, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office of Homeland Security and a budget amendment to incorporate said grant funding in the 2009 budget, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office of Homeland Security in the amount of \$50,000 regarding the Regional Pet and Companion Animal Sheltering Program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2009 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A4306 Homeland Security by \$50,000

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.2 by \$50,000 by increasing Line Item A3110 2 2800 Specialty Equipment by \$50,000

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
