AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CORNELL COOPERATIVE EXTENSION REGARDING COMPREHENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT AND SUPPORT SERVICES TO FAMILIES RECEIVING CHILD-ONLY TANF FUNDING

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension regarding Comprehensive Case Management and Support Services to Families receiving Child-Only TANF funding commencing January 1, 2008 and ending December 31, 2008, in an amount not to exceed \$134,800, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the program is designed to improve the quality of life for children by establishing links to community resources, provide case management services and partnering with 16-17 year olds to establish self sufficiency, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension regarding Comprehensive Case Management and Support Services to Families receiving Child-Only TANF funding commencing January 1, 2008 and ending December 31, 2008, in an amount not to exceed \$134,800, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
