

## **RESOLUTION NO. 100**

### **AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NYS GOVERNOR'S TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REGARDING A TRAFFIC SAFETY CORRIDOR ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM**

By Public Safety Committee, Messrs. Beston, Morse and Scavo:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to apply to the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee for a \$16,475.04 Traffic Safety Corridor Enforcement Program grant to target aggressive driving along a section of the Interstate 787 corridor in an attempt to reduce accidents, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that the grant would reimburse the Sheriff's Department for participation with the New York State Police and the Cohoes and Watervliet Police Departments in a stepped-up enforcement project from April 1, 2008 through September 30, 2008, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that the I-787 corridor from the Watervliet City line to the City of Cohoes has been identified as an area where a combination of speed, aggressive driving behaviors and driver inattention have contributed to fatalities and elevated accident statistics, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit an application for \$16,475.04 in Traffic Safety Corridor Enforcement Program funding to the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee regarding the Interstate 787 Corridor traffic enforcement program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
