

RESOLUTION NO. 159

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AN AGREEMENT REGARDING THE COMMUNITY PROSECUTION PROGRAM AND AMENDING THE 2008 DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S BUDGET

WHEREAS, The District Attorney's Office has indicated that the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services has notified his office that grant funding in the amount of \$50,000 is available regarding the Community Prosecution Program for a two year period commencing April 1, 2007 to March 31, 2009, and

WHEREAS, The State Aid will be used to support the Community Prosecution Program, Bring it to the Courts basketball program and the Community Accountability Board, and

WHEREAS, The District Attorney has requested authorization to submit the grant application and enter into a two year agreement with the Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding the Community Prosecution Program, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application to the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding the Community Prosecution Program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Executive is authorized to enter into a two year agreement with the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding the Community Prosecution Program in the amount of \$50,000 for the period April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2009, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2008 District Attorney Budget is amended to reflect a reallocation of expenses as follows:

Decrease Appropriation Account A1165.4 by \$13,000 by decreasing Line Item A1165 4 4046 000 Fees For Services by \$13,000

Increase Appropriation Account A1165.1 by \$2,000 by increasing Line Item A1165 1 9970 000 Temporary Help by \$2,000

Increase Appropriation Account A1165.2 by \$3,000 by increasing Line Item A1165 2 2999 000 Miscellaneous Equipment by \$3,000

Increase Appropriation Account A1165.4 by \$8,000 by increasing Line Item A1165 4 4039 000 Conferences/Training/Tuition by \$8,000

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
