WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation regarding the maintenance and operation of the section of the Mohawk-Hudson Bike-Hike Trail that is located in the City of Cohoes, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the Department of Public Works will be responsible for the operation, maintenance and repair of the bike-hike trail for a period of twenty-five years commencing on the day the agreement is signed, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation regarding the maintenance and operation of the section of the Mohawk-Hudson bike-hike trail that is located in the City of Cohoes, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
