

RESOLUTION NO. 411

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 433 FOR 2007 REGARDING PREVENTIVE SERVICES FOR CHILDREN

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 433 for 2007, this Honorable Body authorized service agreements with providers regarding preventive services for children for the term commencing January 1, 2008 and ending December 31, 2008, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services has requested authorization to extend the contracts with the providers listed below for the period January 1, 2008 through March 31, 2009 rather than January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the three month extension will allow sufficient time to review the new proposals under an RFP that was recently released and change the cycle of the County agreements to coincide with the State fiscal year, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 433 for 2007 is amended to indicate that the term of the agreements with the following preventive service providers is extended to March 31, 2009 rather than December 31, 2008 at the amounts indicated:
