

RESOLUTION NO. 474

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION REGARDING A STUDY OF THE RAILROAD AVENUE CORRIDOR

By Audit and Finance Committee, Messrs. Clay and Scavo:

WHEREAS, The County Executive has requested authorization to submit a joint grant application with the Towns of Colonie and Guilderland to the Capital District Transportation Committee Linkage Planning Program to fund a study on the Railroad Avenue Corridor, and

WHEREAS, The grant funding would be used to hire a consultant to identify access and infrastructure improvements to the Railroad Avenue corridor which is part of the Albany County Empire Zone, and

WHEREAS, The grant in the amount of \$50,000, has a 25% cash match to which the Town of Colonie has committed \$5,000, the Town of Guilderland has committed \$2,500 and Albany County as the lead agency has committed \$5,000, with CDTC providing \$37,500 in federal funds, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a joint grant application with the Towns of Colonie and Guilderland in the amount of \$50,000 to the Capital District Transportation Committee, Linkage Planning Program to fund a study on the Railroad Avenue Corridor, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
