WHEREAS, Emailing reports and other matters would conserve paper and stamps and the time it takes County-paid staff to photocopy the reports and address envelopes, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That it shall be the policy of Albany County to communicate by electronic means whenever practicable in the interest of saving money and increasing efficiencies to the benefit of taxpayers, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
