

RESOLUTION NO. 17

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CALLANAN INDUSTRIES, INC. REGARDING THE COUNTY ROUTE 204 (SCHOOLHOUSE, KRUMKILL AND RUSSELL ROADS) REHABILITATION PROJECT IN THE TOWNS OF GUILDERLAND AND BETHLEHEM

By Public Works Committee, Messrs. Clay, Commisso, Cunningham, Domalewicz, Shafer, Ms. Connolly and Mr. McCoy:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has requested authorization to move forward with the reconstruction of County Route 204 (Schoolhouse, Krumkill and Russell Roads) rehabilitation project in the Towns of Guilderland and Bethlehem in order to keep pace with ever-increasing traffic volume and remedy roadway surface imperfections, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the reconstruction of County Route 204 in the Towns of Guilderland and Bethlehem includes construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Schoolhouse and Krumkill Roads, pavement reconstruction, concrete sidewalks, granite curbing, guide rail installation and a new closed drainage system, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works, through the County Purchasing Agent, issued a request for bids and on January 4, 2007 five bids were received pertaining to the project, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works and its engineering consultant, Vollmer Associates, LLP reviewed said bids and recommended awarding the contract to Callanan Industries, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Callanan Industries, Inc., 1245 Kings Road, Schenectady, New York 12303 in an amount not to exceed \$5,659,524.35 regarding the reconstruction of County Route 204 rehabilitation project in the Towns of Guilderland and Bethlehem, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
