AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH BI, INC. REGARDING GPS ELECTRONIC MONITORING OF SEX OFFENDERS

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 202 for 2005, this Honorable Body requested County officials to strengthen efforts to protect children and others from sexual predators, including the possibility of initiating electronic tracking of designated sex offenders convicted of violent crimes and those deemed to be at a high risk of re-offending, and

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 470 for 2005, the Director of the Probation Department, based on a review of bids submitted in response to a request for proposals, was granted authorization to contract with BI, Inc. for GPS electronic monitoring of sex offenders for a one-year period commencing December 1, 2005 and ending November 30, 2006, and

WHEREAS, The Probation Director is requesting authorization to enter into a successor contract with BI, Inc. to provide and maintain electronic monitoring and home detention GPS services for probation-sentenced sex offenders determined to be at high risk to re-offend in an amount not to exceed \$300 per probationer per month, commencing December 1, 2006 and ending November 30, 2007, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with BI, Inc., 6400 Lookout Road, Boulder, CO 80301 regarding GPS electronic monitoring of sex offenders in an amount not to exceed \$300 per probationer per month commencing December 1, 2006 and ending November 30, 2007, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
