AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DIVISION OF PROBATION AND CORRECTIONAL ALTERNATIVES REGARDING THE ALTERNATIVES TO INCARCERATION PROGRAM

By Public Safety Committee and Mr. Collins:

WHEREAS, New York State Law requires that counties develop and submit to the State a Comprehensive Alternatives to Incarceration Service Plan to identify and provide eligible programs which afford alternatives to incarceration to suitable persons, and

WHEREAS, The New York State Division of Probation and Correctional Alternatives has indicated that the County is eligible to receive grants for the program for 2007 in the amount of \$41,700 for the Probation Department and \$28,500 for the Drug Court / ATI Program, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a State aid application to the NYS Division of Probation and Correctional Alternatives in the amount of \$41,700 for the Probation Department and \$28,500 for the defender-based advocacy ATI Program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Division of Probation and Correctional Alternatives for the aforementioned purpose for the County Department of Probation and the Drug Court / ATI Program for a total sum of \$70,200 commencing January 1, 2007 and ending December 31, 2007, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
