AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REGARDING SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 4 FOR THE ALBANY-SHAKER ROAD, ROUTE 7 TO WATERVLIET-SHAKER ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

WHEREAS, By previous legislation, this Honorable Body authorized agreements with the NYS Department of Transportation regarding the implementation and funding of a State "Marchiselli" program-aid eligible transportation federal-aid project, to fully fund the local share of federal and state-aid eligible and ineligible project costs and appropriated funds for the Albany-Shaker Road, Route 7 to Watervliet-Shaker Road Reconstruction Project, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Transportation regarding Supplemental Agreement No. 4 pertaining to the Albany-Shaker Road, Route 7 to Watervliet-Shaker Road reconstruction project, and

WHEREAS, Supplemental Agreement No. 4 amends the project funding enabling Albany County to receive the State's 15% share of the project costs for the right-of-way acquisition phase and extends the completion date of the project from December 31, 2005 to November 1, 2010, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Transportation to accept Supplemental Agreement No. 4, which will allow Albany County to be reimbursed for the State's 15% share of the project costs for the right-of-way acquisition phase and extends the completion date of the project from December 31, 2005 to November 1, 2010 for the Albany-Shaker Road, Route 7 to Watervliet-Shaker Road Reconstruction Project, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
