

RESOLUTION NO. 107

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 191 FOR 2006: ADDITIONAL FUNDING REGARDING THE TUBERCULOSIS OUTREACH PROGRAM

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 191 for 2006, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with the New York State Department of Health regarding the Tuberculosis Outreach Program, and

WHEREAS, The program provides skin testing for early detection in high risk groups including the homeless population and those in drug and alcohol rehabilitation programs, and to offset the costs associated with providing “direct observed therapy” to all active tuberculosis and to those clients at high risk for contracting the disease, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Health has been notified by the NYS Department of Health that it will receive an additional \$947 in Cost of Living Adjustments for the Tuberculosis Outreach Program for the period beginning March 31, 2006 through March 30, 2007, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 191 for 2006 is amended to indicate that the fee corresponding to the Community Health Worker Grant for the period beginning March 31, 2006 through March 30, 2007 is changed to read \$68,587 rather than \$67,640, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
