

RESOLUTION NO. 133

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ALBANY HOUSING AUTHORITY REGARDING INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT AND EMPLOYMENT SERVICES FOR QUALIFYING TANF RECIPIENTS

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the Albany Housing Authority to provide intensive case management and employment services to 100 sanctioned TANF recipients living in the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the Albany Housing Authority will provide the services through its existing contract with Community Technology Initiative, a HUD-related employment service provider, to run an onsite employment program and additionally will sponsor work experience sites for program participants, and

WHEREAS, The agreement regarding intensive case management and employment services for qualifying TANF recipients in the amount of \$98,360 for the period commencing March 1, 2007 and ending December 31, 2007 is based on the ability of Albany Housing Authority to reduce the number of sanctioned families and increase participation in employment activities and job starts, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Albany Housing Authority regarding intensive case management and employment services for qualifying TANF recipients for a term commencing March 1, 2007 and ending December 31, 2007 in the amount of \$98,360, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
