

RESOLUTION NO. 182

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CALLANAN INDUSTRIES REGARDING THE COUNTY ROUTE 157 REHABILITATION PROJECT IN THE TOWNS OF COLONIE AND GUILDERLAND, CITY OF ALBANY AND VILLAGE OF COLONIE

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has requested authorization to move forward with the County Route 157 reconstruction and rehabilitation project in the Towns of Colonie and Guilderland, City of Albany and Village of Colonie in order to keep pace with ever-increasing traffic volume and remedy roadway surface imperfections, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the project includes reconstruction and rehabilitation of the existing roadway to 12-foot travel lanes with eight-foot asphalt shoulders and miscellaneous cold milling/asphalt overlay paving and full depth box out of the shoulders along the highway, along with new concrete sidewalks, concrete curbing, underdrains, asphalt, asphalt rut filling, intersection improvements, new guide rails and pavement striping, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works, through the County Purchasing Agent, issued a request for bids and on March 29, 2007 four bids were received pertaining to the project, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works and its engineering consultant, Stantec Consulting Services Inc., reviewed said bids and recommended awarding the contract to Callanan Industries, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Callanan Industries, Inc., 1245 Kings Road, Schenectady, New York 12303 in an amount not to exceed \$3,571,748.68 regarding the County Route 157 rehabilitation and reconstruction project in the Towns of Colonie and Guilderland, City of Albany and Village of Colonie, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
