

RESOLUTION NO. 281

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT REGARDING PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS PROGRAM AND AMENDING THE 2007 DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S BUDGET

WHEREAS, The District Attorney has indicated that grant funding in the amount of \$72,000 is available through the US Department of Justice regarding the Project Safe Neighborhoods initiative, and

WHEREAS, The focus of Project Safe Neighborhoods is to reduce violent crime in neighborhoods, particularly gun crimes, and

WHEREAS, The District Attorney has indicated that Project Safe Neighborhoods funding will be used to develop an anti-gang, anti-gun media and communications outreach message in the Albany County and to develop a collaborative effort with the Albany Police Department, Albany County Sheriff's Department, US Attorney's Office, Albany County Probation Department and the NYS Division of Parole to identify gang members and persistent offenders, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the US Department of Justice pertaining to the Project Safe Neighborhoods initiative regarding funding in the amount of \$72,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the 2007 District Attorney's Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account 4321 Project Safe Streets by \$72,000

Increase Appropriation Account A1165.4 by \$72,000 by increasing Line Item A1165 4 4317 000 Safe Neighborhoods by \$72,000

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
