**AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH BETHLEHEM VOLUNTEER
AMBULANCE REGARDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN -
DEFIBRILLATION (EMT-D) SERVICES AND AMENDING THE 2007 SHERIFF'S
DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

By Public Safety Committee, Messrs. Cotrofeld, Domalewicz, McCoy, Reilly and Shafer:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Bethlehem Volunteer Ambulance, Inc. to provide Emergency Medical Technicians-Defibrillation (EMT-D), and

WHEREAS, Albany County will provide the Bethlehem Volunteer Ambulance, Inc. with one EMT-D 24 hours a day, seven days a week beginning August 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007 at a cost of \$38,507 and in return the Bethlehem Volunteer Ambulance, Inc. will reimburse the County for said services, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Bethlehem Volunteer Ambulance, Inc. for the period August 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007 regarding Emergency Medical Technicians – Defibrillation (EMT-D), in the amount of \$38,507, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2007 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A2265 Advanced Life Support by \$38,507

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.1 by \$4,583 by increasing Line Item A3110 1 9900 Overtime by \$4,583

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.1 by \$33,374 by increasing Line Item A3110 1 9944 000 Emergency Medical Techn. PT by \$33,374

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.4 by \$50 by increasing Line Item A3110 4 4020 000 Office Supplies by \$50

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.4 by \$500 by increasing Line Item A3110 4 4201 000 Uniforms and Clothing by \$500

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
