The Office of the Sheriff of Albany County is authorized by Article 13, Section 13 of the Constitution of the State of New York. Sworn members in both the law enforcement and corrections components of the Albany County Sheriff's Office are assigned to specific job duties for the purpose of efficient administration of departmental missions. Preservation of life and property through the impartial enforcement of law is a primary mission of every sworn member regardless of the rank or assignment. The detection and prevention of crime is the primary mission of those members who have police authority. The primary mission of sworn members assigned to corrections is custody, care, and control of persons committed to the custody of the Albany County Sheriff by the various courts of competent jurisdiction. The primary mission of sworn members who act as officers of the courts of the county is court security, transportation of prisoners, and the execution of the process of the courts of the county.
