

RESOLUTION NO. 384

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CAYUGA CENTERS REGARDING THE PROVISION OF CLINICAL PREVENTION SERVICES

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 355 for 2015, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with Cayuga Centers regarding the provision of clinical prevention services for a period commencing January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016 in the amount of \$222,205, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to renew the agreement, the second of two one-year renewal options, with Cayuga Centers regarding the provision of clinical prevention services for a term commencing January 1, 2018 and ending December 31, 2018 in an amount not to exceed \$222,205, and

WHEREAS, The agreement provides comprehensive assessment, diagnostic testing, case and specialized therapies provided by a person who has received a Master of Social Work degree, Master of Mental Health Counseling degree or is a licensed Psychologist, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement, the second of two one-year renewal options, with Cayuga Centers regarding the provision of clinical prevention services for a term commencing January 1, 2018 and ending December 31, 2018 in an amount not to exceed \$222,205, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
