

RESOLUTION NO. 392

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ST. CATHERINE'S CENTER FOR CHILDREN REGARDING THE PROVISION OF SPECIALTY PREVENTION SERVICES FOR THE PARENT CARE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to renew an agreement, the second of two one-year renewal options, with St. Catherine's Center for Children regarding the provision of the Parent Care Program for a term commencing January 1, 2018 and ending December 31, 2018 in the amount of \$429,158, and

WHEREAS, St. Catherine's Center for Children's Parent Care Program proposes to continue to serve parents and their children who are significantly affected by developmental disabilities and/or psychiatric disorders and to prevent foster care placement or to expedite permanency for children in foster care, and

WHEREAS, St. Catherine's Center for Children's Parent Care Program will provide specialty prevention services which are clinically based such as assessments, diagnostic testing, clinical and specialized therapies provided by a qualified person or licensed psychologist to include family and individual interviews, contact with collateral agencies, schools, extended family and natural supports and diligent communication with Albany County staff, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement, the second of two one-year renewal options, with St. Catherine's Center for Children regarding the provision of the Parent Care Program for a term commencing January 1, 2018 and ending December 31, 2018 in an amount not to exceed \$429,158, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
