

RESOLUTION NO. 406

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE CANAL CORPORATION REGARDING REIMBURSEMENT FOR MARINE PATROL SERVICES

By Public Safety Committee:

WHEREAS, The NYS Canal Corporation has informed the Albany County Sheriff that funding is available for Marine Patrol Services in the amount of \$15,000, which requires a County match of \$5,000, for a term commencing April 1, 2017 and ending March 31, 2018, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that this funding will be used to enhance efforts in the waterways leading into the canal system at the Hudson River entry point, providing a unique opportunity to enforce maritime regulations prior to entry into the canal thus making the canal system safer for its users, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Canal Corporation regarding the reimbursement for Marine Patrol Services along the canals and canal-way trail in the amount of \$15,000, which requires a County match of \$5,000, for a term commencing April 1, 2017 and ending March 31, 2018, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
